IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION TO CANDIDATES

- 1. For Recruiting Year 2023-24, the recruitment of Agniveers will be carried out in two phases:-
 - (a) Phase I Online Computer Based Entrance Examination (Online CEE).
 - (b) Phase II Recruitment Rally.
- 2. <u>Procedure for Online Registration</u>.
 - (a) All candidates to log in to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in, check their eligibility status and create their profile.
 - (b) Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from 16 February 2023 to 15 March 2023.
 - (c) <u>Examination Fee.</u> Examination fee of Rs 250/- per applicant is to be paid by the candidate for the online examination. The candidate on successfully filling the application will be directed to SBI portal through a link on the website. At the SBI portal make payment of Rs 250/- plus Bank charges as applicable. The payment can be made through any of these payment options available:-
 - (i) Payment Gateway Facility through Maestro, Master Card, VISA, Rupay Cards both Credit & Debit of all major banks.
 - (ii) Internet banking of SBI and other banks.
 - (iii) UPI (Bhim).
 - (d) Duplicate/Incomplete/Erroneously filled application will be rejected.
 - (e) Candidates are required to have an active email & mobile number which will be used for further communication.
 - (f) Candidates should apply only once in response to this notification.
 - (g) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - (h) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - (j) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.
 - (k) Candidate should enter AADHAAR number in online application.
 - (I) For online registration & online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at Army Recruiting Offices on working days from 1000 Hours to 1400 hours.
- 3. Online CEE.
 - (a) Category wise link has been provided on JIA website to enable candidates to practice online CEE as per their category. All candidates are advised to carry out practice at least once before appearing for actual CEE.
 - (b) Animated videos "How to Register" and "How to Appear for online CEE" are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in.
- 4. Candidates are advised to upload only recent photographs on JIA website. In case of uploaded photographs not matching with face, candidate will not be allowed to appear in the online CEE.
- 5. Candidates are to reach at the Examination Centre with colour print out of admit card. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in online test in case anomalies/ irregularities/ incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of selection process.
- 6. The candidates should carry her AADHAAR Card (As displayed on the Admit Card) as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test (Phase-I & II) and Medical Test.
- 7. Details about required educational qualification, physical/ medical standards and job specification are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in under the candidate's login and this information can be accessed by the candidate without signing in.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The selection of candidates will be carried out for **Agniveer (General Duty) Women in Corps of Military Police** as per qualitative requirement (QR):-

- (a) # Upper Age limit will be relaxable upto 30 years of age (As on date of joining training) in respect of widows of Defence personnel who have died in harness.
- (b) Women who are widowed, divorced or legally separated are also eligible provided they do not have any children subject to fulfilling all other eligibility criteria.
- (c) Widows of Defence personnel who have died in harness will be eligible to apply for enrolment as Women Military Police. Such widows even with children will be, however, eligible only if they have not remarried.

Note: Candidates who have appeared in class 10th Board Examination and are awaiting declaration of results are also eligible to apply provided they fulfil all other QR. Such candidates, however, shall only be selected when they produce the original marks sheet during the Phase-II of recruitment process (Internet copy of marks sheet not acceptable) as also such candidates should secure the minimum laid down marks in aggregate as well as in individual subjects for respective category for being eligible to participate in Phase-II (Recruitment rally).

Note :-

- (i) The above marks are fixed depending upon the eligibility of a candidate and has no relation to his performance in Common Entrance Examination (CEE).
- (ii) Maximum bonus marks that can be given is 25 Marks even if a candidate qualifies for more than one type of bonus marks.
- (iii) Only one ward (daughter/son) of Service/Ex-Servicemen/ War Widow/ Widow of Ex-servicemen can avail bonus marks in written examination.
- (iv) Original Certificates to be carried by all above categories at rally site.
- (v) Sports Certificate are valid for two years from the issue date as on first day of the recruitment rally for which the candidate is being screened.
- (vi) In case a candidate is found to have made fake claims at any stage or furnished fake certificate to unfairly secure Bonus Marks, his candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage of recruitment.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 5. 'Agniveer' will be enrolled in the Indian Army under Indian Army Act 1950 for a **period** of four years. 'Agniveer' would form a distinct rank in the Indian Army, different from any other existing ranks. Indian Army is not obliged to retain 'Agniveer' beyond the engagement period of four years.
- 6. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Army, 'Agniveer' will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Indian Army. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria including performances during their four year engagement period and upto 25% of each specific batch of 'Agniveer' will be enrolled in regular cadre of Indian Army. 'Agniveer' will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Army. Selection of the 'Agniveer' for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Indian Army.

- 7. **Employability**. 'Agniveer' enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, at the discretion of the Indian Army.
- 8. <u>Training</u>. On being enrolled, 'Agniveer' will be imparted military training based on Indian Army requirement.
- 9. <u>Leave</u>. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of Indian Army. The following leave may be applicable for 'Agniveer' during their engagement period:-
 - (a) Annual Leave : 30 days per year.
 - (b) **Sick Leave**: Based on medical advice.
- 10. <u>Medical and CSD Facilities</u>. For the duration of their engagement period in Indian Army, 'Agniveer' will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.
- 11. <u>Pay, Allowances and Allied Benefits</u>. 'Agniveer' enrolled under this scheme will be paid an 'Agniveer' package with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (As applicable in Indian Army), Dress and Travel allowances will be paid.
- 12. <u>Terminal Benefits Seva Nidhi Package</u>. 'Agniveer' will be given onetime 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

NOTE : 1 'Agniveer' will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund of the Government.

NOTE: 2 There shall be no entitlement to any gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits incase of 'Agniveer'.

- 13. <u>Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation</u>. 'Agniveer' will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of Rs 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as 'Agniveer' in the Indian Army. 'Agniveer' will not be governed by provisions contained in the Pension Regulations/ Rules for Indian Army.
- 14. <u>Agniveer Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill-Set certificate will be provided to the 'Agniveer' highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during **their engagement period**.
- 15. Personnel enrolled under this Scheme will **not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen Status**.

16. Only unmarried candidates will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveers and they must undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Agniveers who marry during the said period would be released from service. Further, only unmarried Agniveer will be eligible for re-enrolment in regular cadre as Sepoy/equivalent on selection as currently in vogue. Additionally, Women Agniveers would be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such Women Agniveers on becoming LMC due to pregnancy are liable to be discharged /dismissed /released, as applicable, from service on administrative grounds post medical opinion.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

- 17. Recruitment Process. Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases :-
 - (a) <u>Phase-I</u>. Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India.
 - (b) Phase-II. Recruitment Rally by Army Recruiting Office at Rally Venue.

PHASE - I: ONLINE COMMON ENTRANCE EXAM (CEE)

18. Online CEE.

- (a) Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his user name (Which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by SMS/Email.
- (b) Candidates should download their Admit Card & carry a colour printout at the exam centre. All instructions given on Admit Card must be read by the candidates carefully and they should adhere to the instructions.
- (c) Entry gates at exam centre will be opened one and a half hour prior to scheduled time of exam and will close 30 minutes prior to time of exam. No candidate will be allowed to enter once the entrance gate is closed.
- (d) No electronic gadgets are permitted at the exam centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centre:-
 - (i) Frisking at Entry Gate.
 - (ii) Checking of Admit Card & AADHAAR Card at the checking point.
 - (iii) Auto allotment of Exam Hall.
 - (iv) Attendance at Exam Hall gate.
 - (v) Capture of Biometric (Photo & thumb impression) inside the Exam Hall.
 - (vi) Login ID to allotted computer terminal.
 - (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
 - (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.
- (e) Online test will be objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hour or 100 questions in two hours.

- (f) Marking pattern for online test:-
 - (i) Full marks for every correct answer.
 - (ii) Nil marks for unattempted question.
 - (iii) 25% marks shall be deducted for every attempted wrong answer (**Negative marks**).
 - (iv) All questions, if attempted, will be considered for evaluation, even if marked for review.
- (g) Marks scored by the candidates in Online CEE will be normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.
- 19. Additional information for candidates till Phase-I of the selection process:-
 - (a) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - (b) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - (c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.
 - (d) In case any candidate is found using unfair means, the candidate will not be allowed to complete the exam and the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled.

PHASE - II: RECRUITMENT RALLY BY ARMY RECRUITING OFFICE

- 20. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in **Online Common Entrance Exam** result. The Roll No of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a second admit card for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of the Recruiting Office. The admit card for **Phase-II** of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (Profile) on Join Indian Army web portal www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for **Phase-II** at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following documents /certificates in original along with two attested photocopies with them:-
 - (a) <u>Admit Card</u>. Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper 75 GSM paper in black and white only **(Do not shrink the size).**
 - (b) <u>Photograph.</u> Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old. Computerised/Photocopied/Photo shopped photographs will **NOT be accepted.**

(c) Education Certificates.

- (i) Education Certificates with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e. Matric/Intermediate etc from recognised School/College / Board/University.
- (ii) Provisional/online education certificates should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University. School Leaving Certificate (SLC)/ College Leaving Certificate (CLC) may be asked for and all candidates will carry the SLC and CLC.
- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by Block Education Officer (BEO)/ District Education Officer (DEO).
- (iv) List of Education Board recognized by State Governments/ UT administrations is attach as **Appendix 'A'** will only be accepted.
- (d) <u>Domicile (Nativity) Certificate</u>. Domicile (Nativity) Certificate generated online through Bihar/ Jharkhand Government website and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/ District Magistrate which can be verified from Government web site will only be acceptable. **No Tatkal Domicile (Nativity) certificate will be acceptable**.
- (e) <u>Class/Caste Certificate</u>. Class/Caste Certificate generated online through Bihar/ Jharkhand Government website as applicable and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/District Magistrate which can be verified from Government web site will only be accepted.
- (f) Religion Certificate. Religion certificate issued by the Tehsildar/SDM (If religion as "SIKH / HINDU / MUSLIM / CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in the caste certificate).
- (g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster, where the candidate last studied.
- (h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of dispatch. Certificate issued by Mukhiya will not be acceptable.
- (j) <u>Character Certificate Issued by SP/SSP Office</u>. Character Certificate duly affixed with individual's photograph issued digitally by SP/SSP Office of district concerned within last six months which can be verified from Government web site. This is applicable for candidates of Bihar State whereas candidates of Jharkhand are required to bring the one issued by SP/SSP Office of district concerned within last six months.
- (k) <u>Relationship Certificate</u>. Daughter of Servicemen (DOS)/Daughter of Ex-Servicemen (DOEX/Daughter of Widow of Ex-Servicemen (DOW)/Daughter of War Widow (DOWW) candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Records Office only duly signed by Records Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Records Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water mark of the concerned Records.

- (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Rs 10/-Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/ Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit attached as per Appendix 'B'**.
- (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.
- (I) NCC Certificate. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. NCC A/B/C pass certificate will only be accepted. No bonus marks in the final merit to be allotted unless the certificates (Relationship/ Sports/ NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.

Note :- NCC certificate produced at the rally site only will be valid for bonus marks.

(m) Sports Certificate.

- (i) <u>List of Sports</u>. List of Sports for enrolment is attached as <u>Appendix 'C'</u>.
- (ii) Sportswomen who have represented India at international level and State at National level within the last two years as per **para 4(c) above** (For list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible, attention is invited to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website)
- (iii) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team or regional team at District level within last two years with position or medal as **per para 4(c) above** (Sports Certificate should be with registration number and from government recognized sport institutes / bodies) as under :-

- (n) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Candidate must be unmarried female and a citizen of India. Unmarried Certificate for candidates affixed with photograph (Signed and stamped), issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of despatch (Format of Unmarried Certificate is attached as per Appendix 'D' with the Notification).
- (o) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per <u>Appendix 'E'</u>. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit. All details as applicable including records of participation of previous rallies must be duly filled up by typing.
- (p) <u>Certificate of Bonus Marks</u>. All original certificates/ photocopies duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks/ Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.
- (q) PAN Card & AADHAAR Card. PAN Card & AADHAAR Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits schemes.
- (r) Sarpanch/ Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof) within last six months.
- (s) <u>Vaccination Certificate</u>. All candidates appearing for rally should be fully vaccinated for COVID -19 (**First and Second Dose**). The certificate to be produced to authority upon asking.

21. **Tattoo**.

- (a) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/ from tribal areas are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates:-
 - (i) Self certificate to be signed by candidate is attached as **Appendix 'F-I'**
 - (ii) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent body Tattoo(s) as per format at **Appendix 'F-II'** to be signed by one of the following officials:-
 - (aa) DC/DM or SDM of the District/Tehsil where the tribe of the candidate is presently settled (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).
 - (ab) Chairman / Secretary or any other senior member of the Tribe (Name, designation if any and address of the concerned member will be clearly mentioned).
- (b) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/ back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

<u>Note</u>: Candidates are strongly advised to carry all documents at rally site on the day of their physical test & documentation check. No certificate will be accepted during or after the rally except for the nominated day.

(b) <u>Physical Measurement (At Rally Site)</u>. Physical measurement will be carried out as per the Physical standards mentioned at Para 1 above.

(c) <u>Medical Examination</u>.

- (i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test and Physical Measurement Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.
- (ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to Military Hospital/Command Hospital/Base Hospital for specialist review. Candidates referred for specialist review should present themselves to the nominated Military Hospital/ Command Hospital/Base Hospital within <u>five days</u> of referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within <u>seven days</u> as per policy.
- (iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination, review medical examination and medical examination prior to despatch to Training Centre before handing over the Joining Letter. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.
- (iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.
- (v) <u>Gender</u>. Any candidate if found to have predominantly masculine characteristics evidenced on external physical examination will be rejected as UNFIT. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared UNFIT.
- (vi) **Pregnancy**. Any female candidate, if found to be pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature rejected. A candidate should not have conceived at the time of reporting or till conclusion of training at CMP Centre and School engagement and durina four vears of period Agniveer. A Medical Certificate from a Government Medical Doctor (With minimum MBBS qualification) stating the no pregnancy status of a candidate will be produced on reporting for the recruitment rally, and a fresh certificate again, when reporting to the Training Centre, failing which the individual will be rejected summarily.

- (vii) At the time of the recruiting medical examination, all candidates will invariably be required to render a certificate that they do not suffer primary/secondary amenorrhoea, or menorrhagia (This will be explained in a language, and in terms that they understand). Candidates with the above mentioned conditions will be declared medically UNFIT.
- (viii) If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
- (ix) No use of contact lenses.
- (x) Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting them cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally. **They should not visit any quack and get their eardrum damaged**.

<u>Note</u>: Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

Special Instructions

- 1. Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase-II, <u>five days</u> prior to the Rally, may approach <u>concerned Army Recruiting Office</u> for further clarification.
- 2. <u>01 October 2023</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidates. Candidates to produce birth certificate/10th class marks sheet at the time of preliminary document check.
- 3. Candidates are required to report at the **Rally Site** by **0300 hours** on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after 0600 hours without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- 4. Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/Mobile Number like short listed/call letter/joining instructions/result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number is not permitted. **Remember the User Name and Password for future use**. (Recruiting Offices will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong/ changed).
- 5. Candidate must carry their AADHAAR Card as proof of identity which could be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application.
- 6. Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.

- 8. Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.

- 10. A **Grievance Cell** will be established at the Rally Site to redress any grievances.
- 11. Recruitment is purely based on merit depending on available vacancies. Candidates do not have any right to claim recruitment in Army for merely having passed in recruitment process.

Important Instructions

- 10. <u>Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs</u>. Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Any candidate found in possession of or to have used the same will be debarred from further screening. Format attached as <u>Appendix 'H'</u>.
- 11. <u>Amendment in Any Documents</u>. Any amendment made in any document produced at rally site (For e.g. change in name/ DOB/ address in education certificate, AADHAAR Card, PAN Card etc) should be prior to the issue of notification.
