#### **ADVERTISEMENT NO. 34 OF 2023-24**

Recruitment to the posts of Assistant Professor (Super Speciality) of Government MCHs in the rank of Group-A, under Health & Family Welfare Department, Odisha.

Online applications are invited from the prospective candidates through the proforma application to be made available on the Website of the Commission (<a href="http://opsc.gov.in">http://opsc.gov.in</a>). The link for registration /re- registration shall be available from 28.03.2024 to 29.04.2024 (Note: 29.04.2024 is the last date for submission of Registered Online Application) for recruitment to 09 (Nine) posts of Assistant Professor (Super Speciality) in Group-A, under the Odisha Medical Education Service cadre for posting in Government MCHs of the State of Odisha, under Health & Family Welfare Department in the Academic Level-12 of ORSP (MCT) Rules, 2019 with usual dearness and other allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time. The posts are purely temporary for the present and likely to be made permanent in future.

As per Govt. requisition there are no vacancies reserved for candidates belonging to SC, ST, SEBC, PWD, Sports Person, Ex-serviceman and Women categories.

Pursuant to the judgments of the Constitution Bench in the matter of Indra Sawhney case [Indra Sawhney v. Union of India, 1992 Supp(3) SCC 217: 1992 SCC (L&S) Supp 1: (1992) 22 ATC 385], Preeti Srivastava (Dr.) v. State of M.P., [(1999) 7 SCC 120] and Faculty of AIIMS v. Union of India & Ors. [2013 11 SCC 246], reservation shall not be applicable in Super-Speciality disciplines.

3. AGE: A candidate must have attained the age of 21(twenty one) years and must not be above the age of 45 (Forty five) years on the 1st day of January 2024 i.e. he/she must have been born not earlier than 2<sup>nd</sup> January 1979 and not later than 1<sup>st</sup> January 2003.

The upper age limit prescribed above shall be relax-able by 5 (five) years for candidates belonging to the categories of Women & Ex-Servicemen and by 10(ten) years for Persons With Disabilities category, whose permanent disability is 40% and more.

Provided that, the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 5(Five) years in case of in-service Doctors serving on ad hoc basis or contractual basis under the Government or Government undertakings as the case may be.

(SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED).

Date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

#### **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:** 4.

In order to be eligible for direct recruitment, a candidate must,-

- have acquired a post graduate degree in the concerned Super Speciality or any other equivalent degree or qualification prescribed by the MCI/NMC from time to time.
- Where the DM/M.Ch. is of two years duration or of five years recognized course after MBBS, one year teaching and, or research experience in a recognized II. institution in the subject of specialist shall be required after obtaining the qualifying degree of D.M. or M.Ch.
- Those candidates who have undergone Diplomate National Board training in concerned subject are also eligible for the post of Assistant Professor subject to III. fulfilling of any other criteria regarding Diplomate National Board, prescribed by MCI/NMC from time to time in force.
- The Diplomate of National Board (DNB) in Broad Speciality and Super Speciality qualifications when granted in a medical institution with IV. attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of five hundred or more beds, by the National Board of Examiantions, shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding Broad Speciality (MD/MS) and Super Speciality (DM/M.Ch.) postgraduate qualification, but in all other cases, Senior Residency in a medical college for an additional period of one year shall be required for such qualification to be equivalent for the purposes of teaching.
- The candidates who are already appointed as Assistant Professor in a Medical College without experience as SR as per previous guidelines before 08.06.2017 ٧. shall not require the one year experience as SR for applying for Assistant Professor in another Medical College.
- The candidates who are already working as Asst. Professor before 08.06.2017 to undergo SRship, they are exempted from the teaching experience requirement of VI. one year in the concerned subject".

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**5. METHOD OF SELECTION:** The selection of candidates for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor in Super Speciality shall be made on the basis of **Written Test** as per the guidelines as enumerated in Odisha Medical Education Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021.

The candidate must possess DM/M.Ch. degree in the concerned discipline from MCI/NMC permitted or approved or recognized Medical college and/or any other academic qualification with such additional teaching experience in the subject as may be prescribed by MCI/NMC from time to time in force.

Provided that the recruitment may also be made by way of selection from amongst the Assistant Professors in any other Super- Speciality subject, having requisite qualification in the concerned Speciality subject to the condition that seniority in the Super- Speciality in the said discipline, as the case may be, shall be determined from the date of appointment in the new discipline in accordance with the placement given by the Commission, and accepted by the Government.

# Written test will be conducted in the following manner.

- The written test shall be of total 200 marks;
- The total No. of questions shall be 200 and will be of Multiple Choice Questions (ii) (MCQ) pattern;
- Each question shall carry one mark. (iii)
- There shall be negative marking for wrong answers. For each wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted from the marks awarded for correct answers. (iv)
- The qualifying marks in the written examination as decided by the (v) Commission is 35%.
- Duration of Examination shall be of 3 hours; (vi)
- Syllabus: The syllabus for the posts of Assistant Professor (Super Speciality) shall be from Super Speciality subjects (MCI/NMC approved DM/M.Ch. syllabus for (vii) Super Speciality subjects).

Candidates who are native or resident of Odisha shall be given preference over candidates of other States. When two candidates secure equal marks in the recruitment and one of them is not a native or resident of Odisha, then out of the two, the candidate who is native or resident of Odisha shall be given preference for selection.

The Commission shall prepare a list of candidates in order of merit on the basis of written test which shall be equal to the number of advertised vacancies:

Provided that, if two or more candidates secure equal marks, then the candidate securing higher marks in MBBS Examination shall find place above the other in the merit list & in case marks obtained in MBBS Examination is also the same, the candidate older in age shall be placed above the younger.

The list recommended by the Commission shall remain valid for a period of one (01) year from the date of its approval by the Government.

Note:- Any details relating to this recruitment like cut-off marks, answer keys, individual marks etc. shall only be declared on the website of the Commission after publication of the final results and select list.

#### PLACE OF EXAMINATION 6.

The written examination for the post of Assistant Professor (Super Speciality) will be held at Cuttack. The programme of examination shall be notified well in advance.

#### OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS: 7.

- The candidate must be a citizen of India; (i)
- The candidate must be of (a) good moral character, and (b) good mental condition and bodily health, good physique and active habits and free from organic defects (ii) or bodily infirmity so as not to create an impairment in the due discharge of duties;
- A candidate, who has more than one spouse living, will not be eligible for appointment unless the State Government has exempted his/her case from (iii) operation of this limitation for any good and sufficient reasons;

- (iv) Government servants, whether temporary or permanent, are eligible to apply provided that they possess the requisite qualification and are within the prescribed age-limit as provided under Para 3 & 4 of the Advertisement. They must inform their respective Heads of the Office in writing regarding submission of their application for this recruitment and furnish "No Objection Certificate" during document verification;
- (v) Before appointment, a candidate must register himself/herself under the Odisha Medical Registration Act, 1961.
- (vi) If a candidate has at any time, been debarred for a certain period/chance(s) by the Odisha Public Service Commission or other State Public Service Commission or U.P.S.C. from appearing at any examination / viva voce test, he/she will not be eligible for such recruitment for that specified period / chance(s);
- (vii) Only those candidates, who possess the requisite qualifications, are within the prescribed age limit and fulfill other eligibility conditions etc. by the closing date for submission of online application form, will be considered eligible;
- (viii) A candidate who claims change in his/her name after having passed the H.S.C. examination, is required to furnish copy of publication of the changed name in the local leading daily newspaper as well as copy of notification in the Gazette in support of his/her change of name;
- (ix) Every candidate selected for appointment shall be examined by the Medical Board. A candidate, who does not satisfy the requirement after medical examination, shall not be appointed;

#### 8. IMPORTANT POINTS:

- (i) Online applications submitted to OPSC, if found to be incomplete in any respect, are liable for rejection without entertaining any correspondence with the applicants on the score;
- (ii) A candidate found guilty of seeking support for his/her candidature by offering illegal gratification or applying pressure on any person connected with the conduct of the recruitment process or found indulging in any type of malpractice in course of the selection or otherwise, shall, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be disqualified not only for the recruitment for which he/she is a candidate, but also may be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any recruitment or selection to be conducted by the Commission;
- (iii) Admission to examination will be provisional. If on verification at any stage before or after the examination it is found that a candidate does not fulfil all the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be liable to rejection. Decision of the Commission in regard to eligibility or otherwise of candidate shall be final;
- (iv) This advertisement should not be construed as binding on the Government to make appointment;
- Any misrepresentation or suppression of information by the candidate in the application form will result in cancellation of his/her candidature or penalty, as decided by the Commission;

Mere empanelment in the select list shall not confer any right for appointment unless the Government is satisfied after making such enquiry as may be deemed (vi) necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the service;

#### CERTIFICATES / DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED: 9.

Candidates who qualify in the written examination shall be required to bring with them the copies of online application form along with copies of following relevant certificates/documents and originals of the same for verification of their eligibility as per terms and conditions of the advertisement, the date of which will be notified later on in due course, failing which his/her application will be rejected for the said post. The candidates are required to mention on each copy of documents "Submitted by me" and put their full signature and date on the same. All the following certificates must be uploaded with the online application.

# NOTE:1

Candidates who have not been awarded percentage of marks, but only grade marks, should along with their applications, produce the conversion certificate from the concern University including the actual equivalent percentage of marks and the conversion formula, failing which, their applications are liable to be rejected.

- D.M/M.Ch/DNB/Dr.NB/DNB-SS certificate in support of qualification in the concerned Super Speciality discipline as may be applicable issued by the concerned (vi) University/Institutions recognized by MCI/NMC;
- Experience Certificate from the competent authority regarding Tutorship/Senior (vii) Resident-ship, if any.
- Latest Medical Registration Certificate as per the Medical Registration Act, 1961
- Certificate relating to passing of the screening test conducted by the National (viii) Board of Education as prescribed by the Medical Council of India vide Notification (ix) No. MCI-203(9) Regd. 2001, dated 13.02.2002 for Medical Graduate passing out of a foreign University;
- No Objection Certificate issued by the competent authority, if required;
- Four recent passport size photographs (unsigned and unattested) with the printout (x) / hard copy of online application form which has been uploaded; (xi)
- Disability Certificate (indicating percentage of permanent disability) issued by the (xii) concerned Medical Board, wherever applicable;
- Any proof of identity; (xiii)

- (xiv) Ex-Servicemen claiming reservation are required to submit/upload Release Certificate issued as per Orissa Ex-Servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985 vide G.A. Deptt. notification No. 22586-Gen., dt.16.10.1985. Further, Ex-Servicemen candidates must submit an affidavit, undertaking that he/she has not been appointed against a civil post after retirement from military service.
- (xv) Certificate from Competent authority in support of past service as in-service doctor serving on ad hoc basis or contractual basis under Government of Odisha in respect of candidates, who claim age relaxation as serving Doctors. The period of past service will be taken into account by the closing date of receipt of application.

M.D./M.Ch./D.M./DNB/DrNB/DNB-SS Degree Certificate, teaching experience/research experience certificate, *Permanent Disability certificate of Persons with disabilities and* Release Certificate of Ex-Servicemen [issued as per Orissa Ex-Servicemen (Recruitment to State Civil Services and Posts) Rules, 1985 vide G.A. Deptt. notification No. 22586-Gen., dt.16.10.1985] must have been issued by the competent authority within the last date fixed for submission/ receipt of online application form.

#### 10. "GROUNDS OF REJECTION OF APPLICATIONS"

Applications of candidates will be rejected by the Commission on any of the following grounds:-

- (a) In-complete online application form.
- **(b)** Non-submission of hard copy of online application form at the time of verification of original documents.
- **(c)** Not signing Declaration (full signature) in the hard copy of online application form.
- **(d)** Not coming within the age limit as mentioned in Para 3 of Advertisement.
- **(e)** Not having requisite qualification as provided under Para 4 of Advertisement.
- **(f)** Not furnishing copies of certificates/documents as provided under Para 9 of Advertisement.
- **(g)** Submission of wrong information/ false information about qualification/ Age/Category status (Women/Ex-Servicemen/PWD etc.).
- **(h)** Suppression of facts / information about eligibility, if any.
- (i) Any other ground as per the decision of the Commission.
- NB: Application /candidature of a candidate shall be rejected at any stage of recruitment process, when discrepancy is noticed/ detected.

## 11. HOW TO APPLY:

(a) Candidates must go through the details of this Advertisement available in the Website of OPSC before filling up online application form.

(b) Candidates must apply online through the concerned Website of the OPSC <u>http://opsc.gov.in</u>. Applications received through any other mode would not be accepted and summarily rejected.

- (c) Before filling up the online application form, the candidates must go through detailed instructions available at OPSC portal.
- (d) The online application form is automated and system driven & will guide the candidate seamlessly in filling the application. The requisite options shall be enabled and information shall be asked as per data furnished by the candidate. Before filling up the information, ensure that accurate information is fed, for edit option is limited & on confirmation there is no scope for further edit even if wrongful entry has been made while filling up application.
- (e) Candidates are requested to upload the scanned image of latest passport size photograph along with scanned image of his/her full signature and scanned image of Left-hand Thumb Impression (LTI) in the online application form. Uploaded photograph, Specimen (full) signature and LTI must be clearly identifiable / visible, otherwise the application of the candidate is liable to be rejected by the Commission and no representation from the candidate will be entertained.
- (f) Candidates should keep at least four copies of latest passport size photograph which is uploaded to the online application form for future use.
- (g) C'n successful submission of the online Registration, a unique "Permanent Public Service Account Number (PPSAN)" will be assigned to the applicant.

  Candidates are required to take a printout of the finally submitted online Registration/Re-registration and finally submitted Online Application forms and put his/her signature under the declaration for submission to OPSC along with copies of requisite certificate & documents as and when asked.
- (h) The candidates are advised to submit the Online Application Form well in advance without waiting for the closing date to avoid last hour rush.
- (i) Certificate of Admission to the written examination to the eligible candidates will be uploaded in the Website of the OPSC prior to the date of written examination which will be published in the Website of the Commission and Newspapers. The candidates are required to download their Admission Certificate from the Website of the Commission and produce the same at the Examination centre for admission to the written examination. No separate correspondence will be made on this score.
- (j) "Notice" to candidates for written Examination/Document Verification and "Attestation form" shall be uploaded in the website of OPSC prior to the date of written Examination/Document Verification.
- (k) Any complaint on the conduct of examination must be sent to the grievance wing of the Commission by e-mail (opsc@nic.in) within 07 (Seven) days of completion of the examination.
